Wednesday, January 7.

President all cranked up last night with Kissinger regarding reports that Peace Corpsmen were demonstrating against Agnew in Afghanistan. Then today similar reaction to Stuart Loory story in *LA Times* regarding cost of Western White House. Wants me to move ruthlessly to get him removed from White House, by calling F. Murphy. Really mad in the evening when he called me.

Fairly light day, President and Bebe went for drive and walks along the beach to the south. First had a session on trivia. Some items regarding Don and Ed Nixon and a few schedule ideas. Some notes regarding how Connie should schedule Pat Nixon. Came up with big plans for having government use Western White House as year-round conference center when President not here. Wants to have base for justifying the cost - not really necessary since virtually all the major expenditures have been on government property.

I had long afternoon session with Klein and Cliff Miller regarding the plan to reorganize Klein's operation and move Magruder in to run it for him. Herb bought the whole deal with a few exceptions. Then one with Ziegler on same subject, he less accepting, because of need to protect his franchise, but will go along, had no choice, and in long haul it will really help him. Problem will be when conflict arises over control of an interview. Dinner with Ehrlichman and Larry, then long discussion with Larry regarding our operation.
