Saturday, April 4.

President at Camp David. I stayed home to do taxes. President kept calling all day. Mostly with more thoughts for follow up on postal settlement. Concerned because papers today had no support in quotes from our side. Lots from the other. Then he talked to Ehrlichman on same thing - with idea of his contacting key press people. Wants one man in charge and pushes Colson, so it will really be covered.

Called later regarding speech by Tom Shepherd of *Look* which I gave him to read. Got him all stirred up, and now he wants to get Shepherd down here and on staff. I already tried, but we can take another stab.

Still feels the lack of a real PR type - but I still don't see how we can use one - even if we could find him, and I don't think we can.

Kissinger has his Paris meeting today and back here this evening. Will want to get right to President who will be tied up with Duke of Windsor dinner. Then Church tomorrow, with LBJ invited.
