In Key Biscayne. The unwinding process is not succeeding. President on the phone every few minutes with little things to check up on. All uptight regarding UPI failure to give fair crowd estimate at the airport last night, claims he knows it was intentional at the desk (it wasn't, it was a reporter error by Risher). Wants our lawyers mobilized to counteract the huge group from New York that will come to DC Wednesday. Thinks maybe he should go out into the country, get some public acclaim. Worried about whether we're on top of the economy (market dropped 9 points yesterday to new low). Wants Harlow to move in and take control of Senate fight regarding Church-Cooper. Wants a new poll on student protest. Wants to stay on top of the State Department situation, especially check if Sullivan goes to Harriman's meeting on Sunday. Reviewed each project underway, etc., etc.
