Gave President the new New York poll data, showing Goodell in poor third - no chance. He was delighted - called Tom Dewey and had Finch talk to him, had me call Mulcahy in Ireland and Buchanan to get word to Buckley. Wants to go all out now to elect Buckley. Also talked to Attorney General.

Some more discussion of whether to do Legion speech - main problem is bad demonstration situation. President inclined not to - I think would be good.

Dinner at Music Center went well. Buff her usual self, President in great form, especially good toast to Buff. Pat Nixon sick, so Tricia substituted. President loved the show, everyone else pretty disappointed, good idea but bad production.
