Wednesday, September 2.

Finch, Rumsfeld, Mitchell meeting regarding domestic violence turned instead into a discussion of general political situation, and especially New York and Buckley. President made strong point that our problem is to keep Democratic Liberals on the hook on the left, build up the horror tales and hang them, on all their votes for permissive judges and statements designed to pacify students, etc., i.e., our Wisconsin candidate should have blasted Proxmire for the school bombing.

Decided to do Kansas State University, the 500 mile auto race and a press conference in office next week, one in Chicago following week. Long rambling talk regarding need to use Presidential office to lead the country - then President off for golf on his course and I out to beach house for sun and talk with Larry.
