Saturday, September 19.

At Camp David. President up earlier than usual, called at 10:00 to see how Colson doing on Kansas TV. And to follow up on action regarding campus and crime.

At 1:00 called me over to Aspen pool to discuss trip schedule with family. Pat Nixon especially cranked up and wanted to go all over her participation. Had some ideas regarding what she wants to do - only real time available is in Rome. Got a little crosswise with the Stuarts, since they had already worked out a schedule plan. Decided on separate schedule in Ireland Sunday, with Jessamyn West.

President called in evening - back to Kansas deal again. This time worried that State Attorney General action against student demonstrators would look like Republican repression (not very consistent with his demand for hard line). Pushing again on action by us regarding university bombings and assaults on policemen. Wants tough action on both.

Billy Graham called regarding Ky visit. His friend all ready to go to Vietnam, to try to turn him off, on religious grounds, by discrediting Rev. McIntyre. His friend can see Ky privately via his next door neighbor, a Mme. Lay. All rather complex. We may have it turned off anyway, but no harm hitting from a different direction.
