Tuesday, October 6.

Back home - with a late start, to get used to the time change. Light day - with Kishi appointment; a chat with Jessamyn West regarding getting her to help with Nixon Foundation getting family background material, and going on TV to tell the Milhous story; and a short session with Ehrlichman and Shultz to get caught up on domestic matters.

Decided to jazz up the interest in the speech tomorrow by going out to cameras today to announce it himself. Feels we have not built these up enough in the past. He gave it a good shot - and announced meetings with Cabinet and leaders before the speech. So we have a lot going now.

Another long political session this afternoon - after I had met with Rumsfeld, Chotiner, and Dent. Decided on most of our support plans - basically per my recommendations yesterday.
