Monday, November 9.

Key Biscayne. President at Walker's. Called over several times to check up on follow-up. Obviously still completely absorbed with politics. Said he'd been working on organization of states for '72. Wanted to review purge list, talked about people assignments, etc.

Came back about 1:30. Called to say he'd decided to go home tomorrow - move Mexican luncheon to DC. (Pat Nixon doesn't want it here.) Finally talked him out of it with support from Rogers. But that made him mad and he now says he'll go home Thursday - right after luncheon.

Pleased to get MacGregor in White House - but still don't have nut cutter, so will make Dole Campaign Chairman, to give him a title and platform - Mitchell will still run the campaign from the inside.

Apparently had good meeting with the Conservatives last night, very impressed with them.
