Friday, November 13.

Back in DC. Echeverria meeting. President in late, not much action. Did get into Christmas season plans, apparently Pat Nixon raised this last night.

Distressed again by Kissinger's briefing book, always too voluminous. President convinced Kissinger's staff too big and just doing make-work.

Had a meeting with Don and Eddie - usual bitching by Don. And Eddie having employment problems, so President wants me to get him a job - with Nixon Foundation or some environment-type organization.

Not very much today on political. Maybe it's finally fading. Although there will be some articles in Sunday papers, and that will start him off again.

Off to Camp David - then called me in evening, but nothing important. Had report from Mitchell regarding Romney - George won't leave quietly, will have to be fired. So we have to set him up on the integrated housing issue and fire him on that basis - to be sure we get the credit.
