Saturday, October 3.

Ireland. Good welcome at Shannon and motorcade through Limerick and Hospital to Mulcahy's estate, Kilfrush. A spectacular home and setting, in opulent luxury. Good crowds full of Saturday night cheer (and beer). The crowds are boisterous and the cops really tough. Slammed four bad guys in Limerick in very tough fashion.

Mulcahy had dinner for President, Prime Minister, top staff and Rogers. A six course affair - started at 9:30, lasted until 11:00. Then over an hour of Irish entertainment - very good but very long and very late. President and Pat Nixon both exhausted - so it was a little rough on all concerned. Then Chapin came in with his problems as the pressure of the tour finally got to him.
