- John H. Alexander, residing at 1 Beekman Place, New York, New York 10022, USA,

acting in their capacity as sole members, with Mr. Richard M. Nixon above, of said company,

have received, in the following manner, a transfer of capital shares :

1.00 Transfer of shares.

- 1.10 Mr. Richard M. Nixon hereby transfers and conveys under the usual legal guarantees, to Mr. Richard S. Ritzel, who agrees, the 25 shares of FF 100 each, numbered 51 to 75, owned by him in the Société d'Etudes et de Contrôle Juridiques.

Mr. Richard S. Ritzel shall be the owner of the shares transferred as from today and shall be the sole beneficiary of the fraction of profits of the current fiscal year distributed to such shares.

He shall be subrogated to all rights and legal obligations attached to the shares transferred.
