Dear Mr. Wolley:

Enclosed is a list of all the people who participated in our Nixon Day Rally and three copies of the write-ups in three different newspapers.

Our Rally was a huge success inasmuch as this was the largest single crowd ever to assemble for a political candidate in our county. We are certain the newspapers underestimated the crowd as I had expert appraisals ranging from 18-25,000 made by men who are accustomed to estimating such crowds. Nevertheless, we are grateful to receive as favorable publicity as we did. Our workers were superb and our whole affair went off like clockwork.

I talked with Tom Sedlar yesterday and sent him a copy of the newspapers together with the list of key workers so that he could complete his report.

I don't know if you are aware of the fact or not that a picture of our crowd appeared in the New York Times on Sunday, October 30.

I hope we have as successful a meeting for the Vice President in Detroit next Monday. I am on my way now to see if I can help this group in any way to make their meeting a success.
