



Dear Stan:

You have no idea what a comfort it is to be able to say 'Stan says' every time anybody comes up with any arguments. Saves so much time that the job is going forward with smoothness and dispatch.

The Women's Club (bless their hearts) has whirled into action and are sponsoring and taking complete charge at the Lyric, but are pulling out all stops on promoting the UMD.

Dr. Darland, of the U, called and will give every effort the U can produce--I asked for all their foreign students, which are quite numerous, to be on hand in a group. Day after tomorrow, when the big things are wrapped up, we'll give some attention to figuring out just what to do with them.

The whole 8th district, not just the party officers but the contact list I have developed when I really want a job done have been alerted. In two more days we mail out an order. They have been asked to report to us what kind of promoting they are doing and how many they will produce. We have friends in the Junior League, AAUW, League of Women Voters, etc. and have arranged for their membership lists to be called, plus our citywide calling that will be done by precinct through our own organization.

Miss Mitchell and I are developing two lists, either or type of thing, and will put one in the mail as soon as we receive your confirmation of night or daytime. Tomorrow morning I will begin bugging the state office to tell me exactly how many and which local candidates are coming.

I can understand that you do not trust people to produce these things and so try for on the spot answers--also that the sooner you get them the better. But I see no sense in sending you facts and then changing them.

Give us confirmation on the general plan and I will have any answer you need. O.K.?
