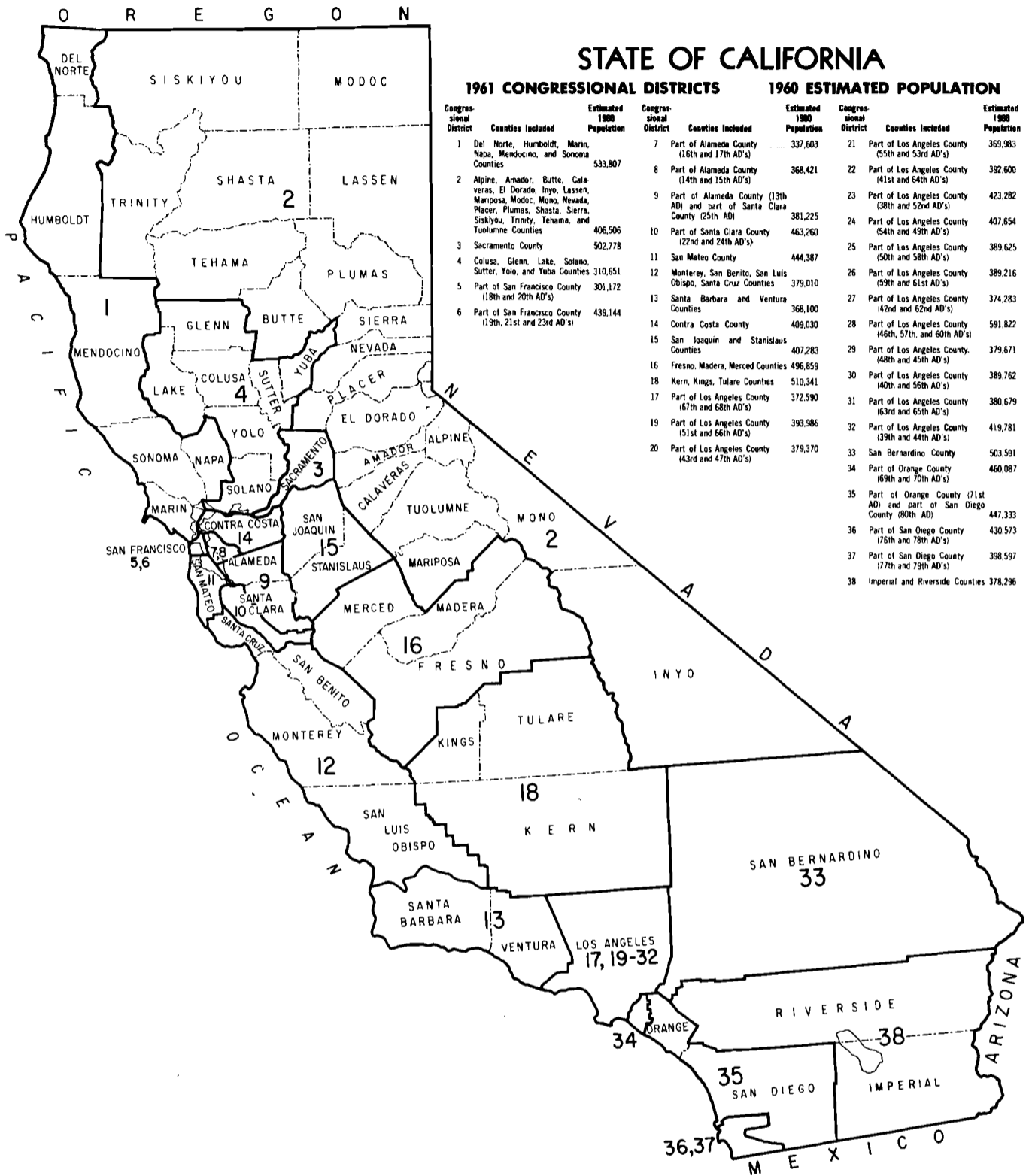

(District Population—1960 Census)

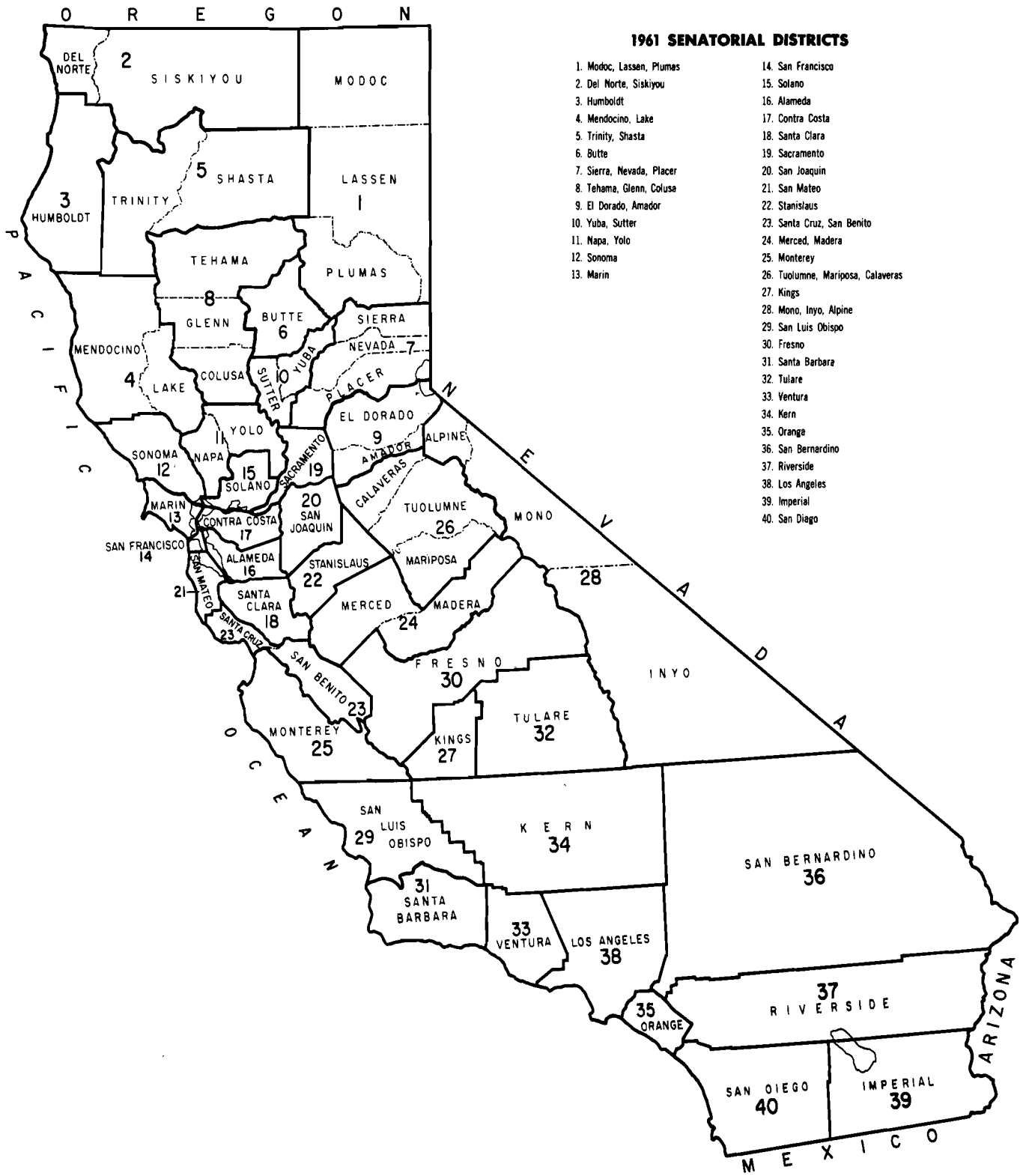

(Incumbent Senators and District Population)



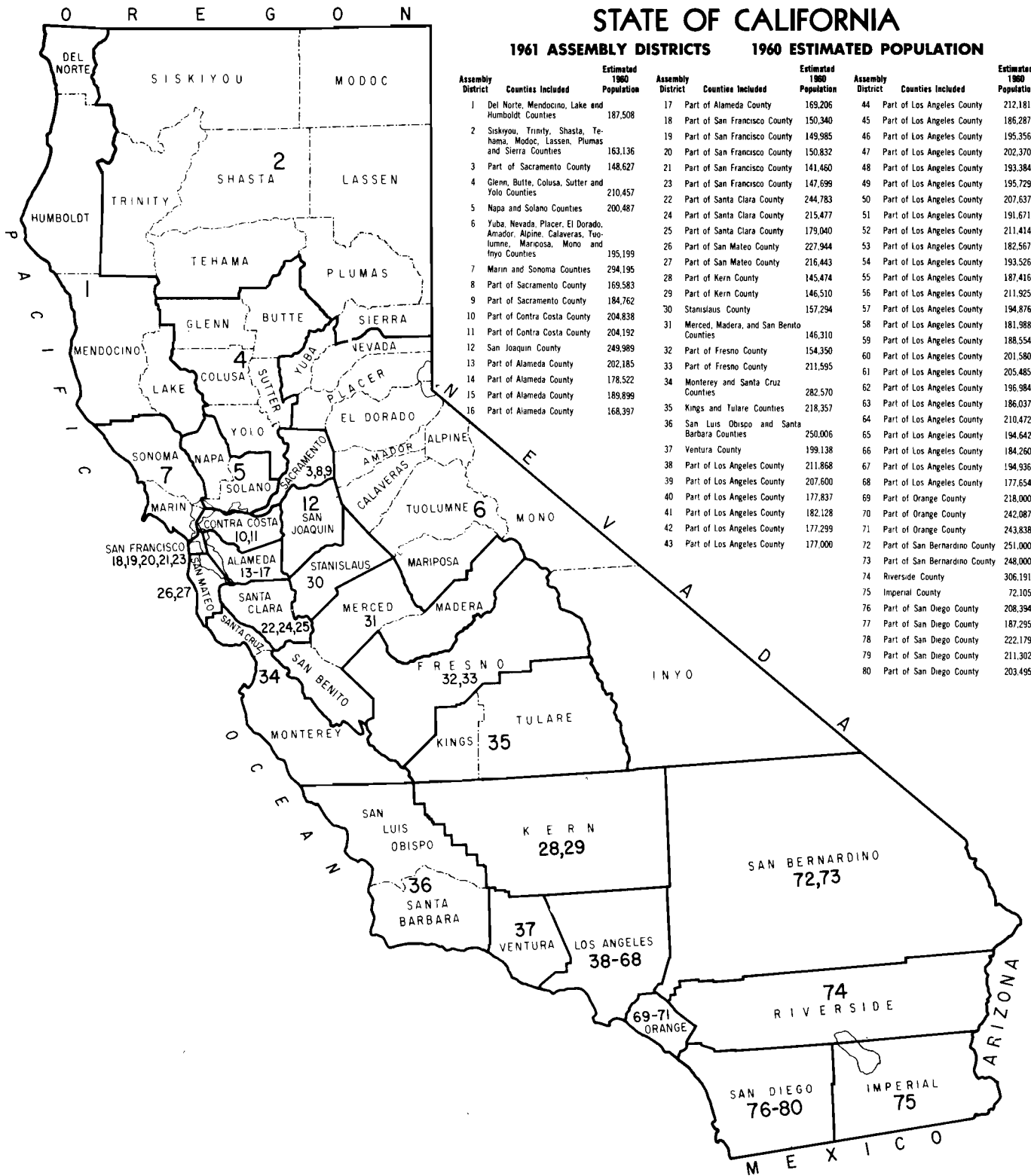
