Saturday, February 13.

At Key Biscayne. The President went over to Grand Cay last night, which was fortunate because the weather at Key Biscayne has been terrible with rain all Friday afternoon and into the evening. He took Rogers and Bebe with him, left the wives here. They returned about 4:30 this afternoon. The President called when they got back. He said it had been good that Bill had gone over, because it gave a good impression of the two of them working together, and also Bill went over to Walker's and talked with the press. The President wanted to be sure we had shown enough concern for California and the earthquake situation. He was wondering what plan we had come up with for the press conference, and I had a couple of other minor odds and ends to check on. And that was about it.
