Friday, September 3.

President came in late this morning. He was only in the office for about a half an hour before departure. Covered, very briefly, the Colson plan on follow-up on the economic moves. He wants him to get it down to a few really good things, particularly to cut down on the quantity of Presidential participation. He also wanted to be sure that I followed up on the Jonathan Rose plans for California, for 100,000 jobs; and then he's concerned that there hasn't been adequate follow-up in this kind of area. He left at a little after 11:30 for Ohio, then Chicago, then Washington. Chapin called this evening to report on the trip; said all had gone well. Chicago crowd was tremendous and very enthusiastic, and he feels we came out in good shape on the trip.
