Monday, June 23.

Nothing new. W.E. Burger swearing in at Court. Very impressive - especially President who spoke eloquently, without notes. Made point history would record not Warren Court, but Supreme Court. Still complaining regarding Harlow-BeLieu handling of Congress preparation. Wants Kissinger to talk to staff regarding not criticizing President's actions and words.

Furious this evening regarding arrangements for Congressional boat trip. Kept calling me because was ready a half hour early. Had to wait. Four calls from Residence, one from car, one from boat. Also upset about press story that he had turned down Warren ceremony Sunday - but had nothing else scheduled. Wants me to find who's responsible and fire him.
