Sunday, November 9.

Home again. One call from President in mid-afternoon. Wanted a special push on project to get maximum Congressmen and Senators to sign letter or resolution, because Hanoi will respond to speech on Thursday in Paris and House won't vote on resolution until next week, -so wants some show of positive support now. Talked to Harlow on this, President had already called him, and Gerry Ford.

Other than that he wanted a follow-up on Julie's trip to Indiana - because large groups came out with "Silent Majority" signs, and President thought this would be great for TV coverage.

Then he was off on the boat for a couple of hours. Will meet with Laird, Rogers and Mitchell on the plane on the way back, leaving at 8:30 tonight. They have been down there all weekend waiting for a session with President - but all understood he was there for the rest, which I guess he really got.
