Friday, August 28.

President talked about Real Majority and need to get that thinking over to all our people. Wants to really ram this home and make all decisions based on it. Very impressed with Buchanan memo analyzing it. Wants to hit pornography, dope, bad kids.

Pleased with idea of Moynihan trip to UN and Asia before announcing him as UN Ambassador - wants me to brace Rogers on it, and have him talk to Pat to set it all up. Talked about economy. Hard to believe it keeps improving - want to be sure we have plan for handling any drop, i.e., CPI or other bad news.

Decided to send Finch to American Legion to face the mobs. He's delighted, as is Rogers who didn't want to go. Chance for Finch to gain some conservative credentials, and pick up lots of attention.

All the Nixon Foundation Trustees had their chance at him at reception after board meeting. Clem Stone especially interruptive during meeting with odd questions - Whittier and Irvine presented site proposals.
