The subject gentlemen are all flying out to California aboard commercial transportation. Details are as follows:

Bebe Rebozo -  
National Airlines Flight #41 (originating in Florida) -

Friday, April 30

Bebe will go over to TWA and meet Messrs. Lewis and Abplanalp. A White House driver and car will meet the three men at the TWA arrival area and carry them to San Clemente. They will not attend the Camp Pendleton ceremony. This has been worked out with Bebe.
